Responsibilities:

- Scheduling & creating graphics for social media posts + adverts
- Reaching out to promoters & hirers - collating assets + communicating on timelines
- Sending regular newsletters out via MailChimp
- Keeping our visual identity fresh and engaging
- Creating PR material and responding to media enquiries
- Managing website content, via Wordpress
- Preparing reports and analytics on the organisation's activities

- The ability to take initiative and work independently, as well as working within and contributing to our team
